


Community Survey Overview

- 447 parents, staff, and students (RHS & UMS) responded

Programs Satisfaction & Importance

Program Satisfaction & Importance – Summary of Findings

Program Importance

• For every aspect that was surveyed ALL responses averaged within the 'Important' to 'Most Important' range. (This means that the survey focused on areas of importance!)

Program Satisfaction – All Respondents

- All programs and services offered (e.g. academics, performing arts, special education, STEM, athletics, etc.) all scored within the 'Satisfied' to 'Most Satisfied' range when averaging all respondents.
- **Academics** floated to the top in both importance and level of satisfaction with an average satisfaction rating of 3.93'.
- **Standardized Test Prep** scored lowest of our programs. 3.4 Satisfaction and 3.66 Level of Importance. This is still in the 'Satisfied' and 'Important' range.

Program Satisfaction—By Respondent Type

- Staff and Students are generally more satisfied then Parents.
- **Special Education**: average satisfaction was lower for Parents (2.11) and Students (2.36) compared to Staff (3.64)
- Staff indicated 'Satisfied' to 'Most Satisfied' in <u>all areas except</u> Business/Tech Education (2.98),
 RHS Athletics (2.84) and Family & Consumer Sciences (2.60).
- Parents indicated 'Satisfied' to 'Most Satisfied' in only the following areas: Academics, Health & Phys Ed, Performing Arts, and STEM. Parents rated all other areas less than Satisfied (3.0) to Less Satisfied (2.1) with Special Ed being the lowest (2.11).
- Students indicated that they were less than Satisfied' with **Special Ed** (2.36), **Student Support Services** (2.71) and **Standardized Test Prep** (2.87).






Programs - Satisfaction & Importance **- ALL Respondents**






Level of Satisfaction

Rating Satisfaction & Importance of Various Aspects that are Specific to the Individual Schools

Individual Schools - Satisfaction & Importance – Summary of Findings

RHS

• Outdoor Field scored 2.56 which is below 'Satisfactory' level across all respondents. This was consistent throughout all 3 groups of respondents.

UMS

• **Gym** (2.81) and **Outdoor Play Area** (2.9) scored the lowest levels of satisfaction across combined respondent groups. This is true for the Parent and Student populations as well. The only exception was that the Staff rated the Outdoor Play Area in the Satisfactory range (3.05).

Pierrepont

- Auditorium (2.43), Gym (2.64), Outdoor Play Area (2.69) and Class Size (2.80) all fell under the Satisfactory level across combined respondent groups.
- Parent responses are in line with the combined groups.
- Staff rated the Outdoor Play Area as Satisfactory (3.0). Staff average rating for **Class Size** nears Least Satisfied (1.79).
- Students rated only the **Auditorium** as less than Satisfactory (2.88). Students rated the Gym (3.13), Outdoor Field (3.17), and Class Size (3.65) in the Satisfactory range. It is worth noting that the students surveyed included only RHS and UMS (who may not be Pierrepont alum but may just have familiarity with the facility).

Individual Schools - Satisfaction & Importance – Summary of FindingsContinued

Washington & Lincoln Schools

- Washington & Lincoln receive high ratings in all aspects with **Class Size** being the lowest and even that is 3.7 (above Satisfactory level).
- The results were consistent across all respondent groups with the exception being Students rating Technology (3.41) lower than Class Size, but even these are above Satisfactory level. Furthermore RHS and UMS Students may not be familiar with current Technology in these facilities.

Kindergarten Center

- The Kindergarten Center received Satisfactory and above ratings in all categories across combined respondent scores. Parent averages were the consistent with the combined respondent ratings for these categories.
- Staff rated **Outdoor Play Area** (2.2), Gym (2.4) and **Auditorium/Assembly Space** (2.5) all less than Satisfactory.
- There were very few Student responses for the Kindergarten Center and the ratings are outliers as these students (RHS & UMS) have not attended the facility and may have limited familiarity.











RHS - Satisfaction & Importance – **Students**




UMS - Satisfaction & Importance **- ALL Respondents**








UMS - Satisfaction




Pierrepont - Satisfaction & Importance **- ALL Respondents**








Pierrepont - Satisfaction















K-Center - Satisfaction & Importance — **ALL Respondents**






K-Center - Satisfaction



K-Center - Importance




Question 7: Importance of Skills & Abilities

Importance of Skills & Abilities – Summary of Findings


Respondents were asked to rate the importance of various skills and abilities to prepare students for the future.

- All skills rated in the Very Important to Most Important range with 4.77 being the highest rating for a skill (self-confidence, independence, responsibility) and 4.26 being the lowest rating for a skill (environmental responsibility). However even the lowest rated skill is highly valued by all respondent groups.
- Comparing the respondent groups average responses, Students rated every skill lower than Staff and Parents did.

Trends Found in Open Comments Section

Comments appeared more than ten times in the following areas:

- Class size
- Facilities
- Maintenance
- Athletic Program
- Gym Size
- Playgrounds
- Special Education
- Security

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Class Size

Class Size: Sampling of Comments (approximately 55 comments)

- Inadequate at Pierrepont
- Too large at K -3 level
- Classrooms overcrowded

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Facilities

Facilities: Sampling of Comments (approximately 39 comments)

- RHS- field needs to be updated/turfed, auditorium updated, Mortimer windows replaced, landscaping/fence replaced, would like building appearance more uniform
- Union- gym too small for age of student, auditorium needs updating, AC in auditorium/gym
- Pierrepont- overcrowded, no large group space, lacks AC in gym and multipurpose room, needs gym expanded

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Maintenance

Maintenance: Sampling of Comments (approximately 39 comments)

- Pierrepont outdated; uninviting, cramped
- RHS auditorium needs updating (curtains, seating, lighting), grounds need refreshing, field maintenance, modernizing bathroom and improved cleanliness

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Athletic Program

Athletic Program: Sampling of Comments (approximately 30 comments)

- Union- Start middle school feeder program; Middle school program will compete with REC; town too sports minded
- RHS- Add additional sports like Lacrosse, crew, boys' volleyball
- Too much money/emphasis on sports
- Add some more options to physical education classes (ex. yoga)

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Gym Size

Gym Size: Sampling of Comments (approximately 26 comments)

- K Center gym is too small, has poles and no air conditioning
- Pierrepont no auditorium to gather as group, no air conditioning, too tight in gym, parents could not get in for Back to School Night, no outdoor gym space
- Union gym too small, overcrowded, inclement weather days pose a problem, no air conditioning

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Playgrounds

Playgrounds: Sampling of Comments (approximately 16 comments)

- Washington needs expanded playground
- Lincoln and Washington preschool play area
- K Center needs expanded playground and safer blacktop area
- Pierrepont needs equipment and/or proper play space

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Special Education

Special Education: Sampling of Comments (approximately 15 comments)

- More resource classes/continuum of services
- Too crowded in LLD
- More teacher/aide training
- RTI should be small group instruction out of the classroom
- Seem to offer the same modifications, but many types of disabilities

Trends Found in Open Comments Section – Security

Security: Sampling of Comments (approximately 13 comments)

- RHS open doors at night (sports, adult school, Rec); can get in via those exiting
- Union/Pierrepont enter near classrooms; not near main office
- Able to enter buildings after school due to facility usage

Findings – Overall Trends

- Modernize facilities
- Improve communication
- Update security

Findings – Overall Trends - Modernize Facilities

- Overcrowded classrooms at all schools, especially Pierrepont
- RHS outdoor field (unusable due to poor condition)
- RHS auditorium needs refreshing
- Pierrepont Multipurpose Room and Gym needs updating/larger size
- Union Gym needs updating/larger size
- Update Science labs at Union and RHS
- RHS Mortimer Avenue wing needs updating
- K Center playgrounds need updating
- K Center Nurse's suite
- Long-term solution for bus parking/storage

Findings – Overall Trends – Improve Communication

- Full-time public relations/communications director
- Bi-lateral communications: Rutherford and BOE
- Continued outreach for Special Education; out-of-district students participating in:
 - Family Fun Nights
 - Socials
 - Teams
 - Musical events
- Follow-up about survey results identifying Special Education as an issue
- Increase parent communication
- Inform realtors

Findings – Overall Trends – Update Security/Safety

- Limit school access points:
 - During school hours
 - After school hours
- Modernize Cameras/Police Monitoring:
 - Common areas
 - Points of entry
- Modernize sensors
- Modernize integrated system with Police

Findings – Overall Trends – Topics to Consider
